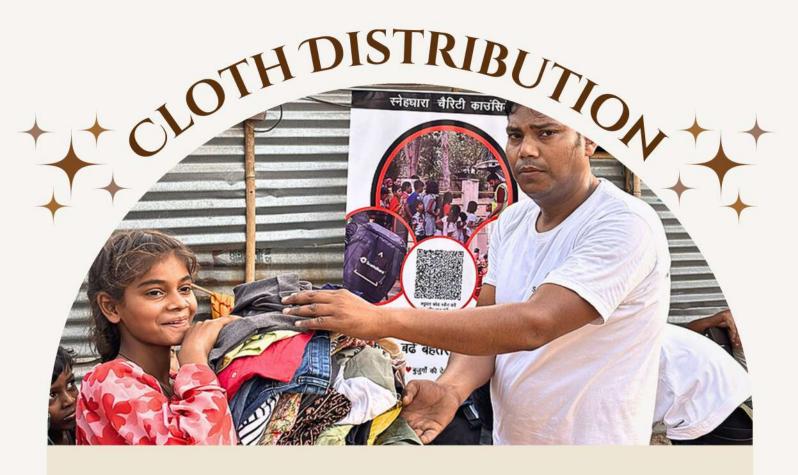


CHANGE STARTS SMALL—BUT IT REACHES FAR

This month, Snehdhara reached places where help is often missing—narrow lanes of slum communities, busy factory clusters, crowded government hospitals, and quiet homes for the forgotten.

We carried warmth in the form of donated clothes to families living with very little. We served hot meals to daily-wage workers who often finish long days on an empty stomach. We stood by new mothers in government hospitals with baby kits, offering simple items that made a big difference. We spoke to women about periods—openly, with respect—and handed out sanitary pads without shame. And we continued our regular support at Anandashram, a home for abandoned men with disabilities, making sure they had diapers, dry rations, and most importantly, dignity. None of this is big in size. But it's big in meaning. Because in all these moments, what we truly give is care. Not just things—but the feeling that someone sees them, someone is there.

At Snehdhara, we believe real change doesn't come from grand speeches or one-day drives. It comes from showing up—again and again—where people are, and meeting their most basic needs with respect and love. With your support, we will keep going. 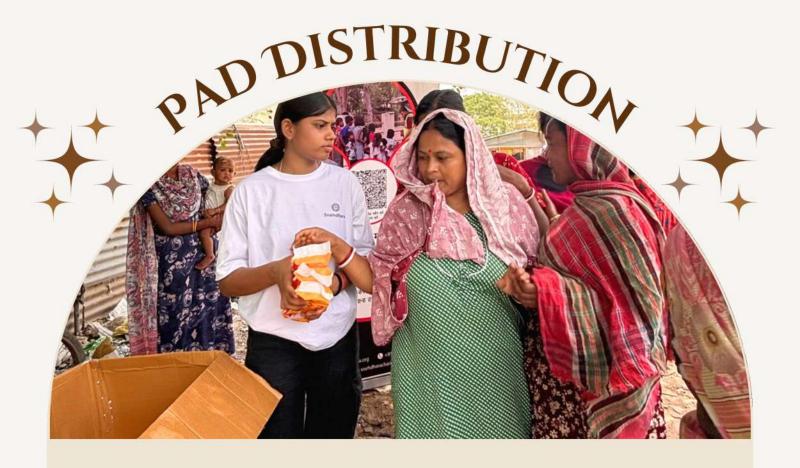


Every meal served was a quiet act of solidarity—a reminder that no one should be left to hunger in the shadows of progress.
