At Snehdhara, this thought guided us through August as we reached 85 elderly residents at Anandashram with monthly rations and 150 packs of adult diapers, supported 100+ new mothers at Civil Hospital with baby kits, and distributed over 1,200 sanitary pads to women in Sectors 48 and 70. Each initiative was more than just distribution—it was about dignity, care, and reminding people that they matter.

From 200 families clothed in Sector 70 to 3,000+ meals served through our weekly food drives, every effort carried the spirit of empathy. This month, we also went heavy-duty on sustainability—replacing plastic with eco-friendly

materials in our drives and partnering with Uppal Southend

RWA to donate nearly 10,000 leaf plates, replacing their thermocol use during festive gatherings.

Together with our volunteers and supporters,

we celebrated the spirit of freedom not just in words but through freedom from hunger, neglect, silence, and waste. As we continue this journey, we invite you to walk with us—because compassion grows stronger

when it's shared.
