From children who needed winter wear to elders who lacked basic clothing, every item added ease to someone's everyday life. Because what is old for one can truly be new for another.

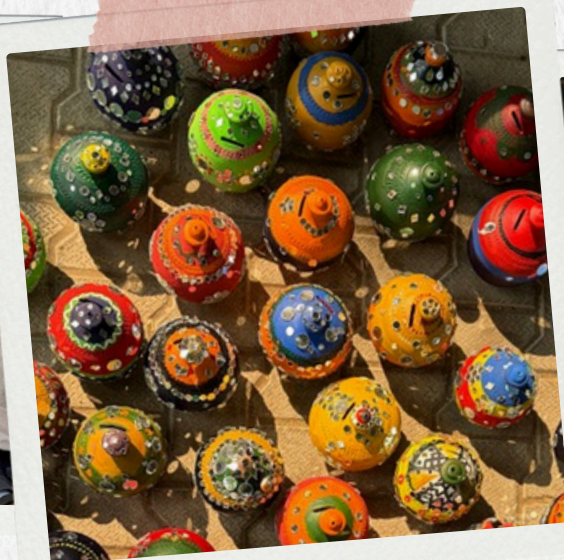


# Children's Day
